### Two year old Classes

Tuesday and Thursday 9am-12pm  
(Child must be two years old by August 31  
to be eligible)

### Three year old Classes

Monday and Wednesday, 9am-12pm  
Tuesday and Thursday, 9am-12pm

### Four year old Classes

Monday, Wednesday, Friday, 9am- 12pm  
(Child must be developmentally ready)

### Four day Class (for 4 and 5 year olds)

Monday through Thursday, 9am-12pm  
(Child must be developmentally ready)

### Five day Class (for older 4 and 5 year olds)

Monday through Friday, 9am-12pm  
(Child must be developmentally ready)  
This is not a kindergarten program.

## LUNCH BUNCH PROGRAM

### Three year olds through five year olds

No sign up is required. Must be toilet  
trained to attend. Available on the days  
that your child attends school. Parent pro-  
vides child's lunch.

Available from 12- 2:30 pm  
The cost is \$3.00/half hour.

## EARLY BIRD PROGRAM

### Two year olds through five year olds

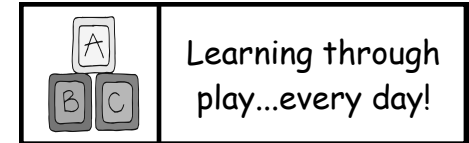
Available every morning your child is in

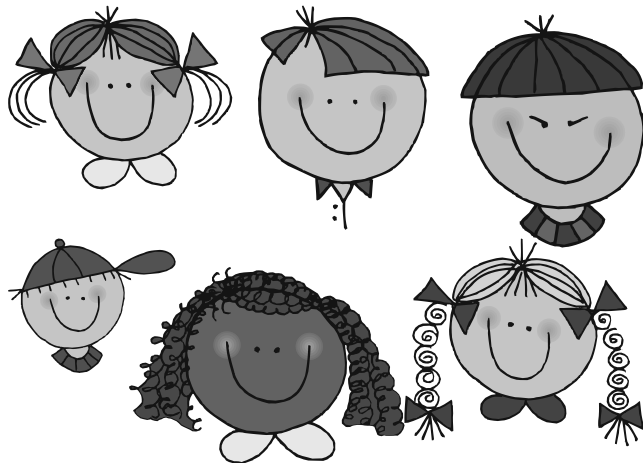

## PURPOSE

"The purpose of the Day school is—to provide a Christian school built upon a sound educational program for young children of this community, as part of the Christian outreach of the Valley Presbyterian Church; and to provide a creative environment, in which meaningful relationships can develop between home and school, child and teacher, and the world around him."

## PROGRAM

The emphasis of the Day School is learning through experiences with art, music, dance, blocks, stories, climbing, conversation, carpentry and gardening. Equal emphasis is placed on developing social, emotional, physical, cognitive and pre-academic skills.

## PEOPLE IN OUR SCHOOL

### CHILDREN

We make no restrictions as to a child's religion or race. To be enrolled, however, he/she must be two years old by August 31st of the school year. A child must have an up to date immunization record. Ages three years and older need to be toilet trained.

Please bring a complete change of clothing, a family photo, a paint shirt for easel painting, and a towel for resting, with his/her name clearly marked on each item. Two year olds need to bring diapers, wipes and extra clothing.

### TEACHERS

Two loving and warm teachers with a background in early childhood education, and church school experience are assigned to each class. The teachers participate in "in-service" training and workshops.

### PARENTS

A variety of opportunities for parents are offered, including classroom substitute teacher, refreshments for parents' meetings, carpentry projects, gardening, readers and snack helpers. Conferences are encouraged and a classroom observation is suggested for all families. We plan a special Father's Visiting Day in early spring and a Mother's Tea in May.

### REGISTRATION

Children currently enrolled in the school and their siblings, church member families and previously enrolled families are pre-registered during the first two weeks of February. Starting February 14th, new students are enrolled on a "first come first registered basis". The first month of tuition is due by August 1st of the school year.

### SCHOOL SCHEDULE

Our school follows the Scottsdale public school calendar, since a majority of the children are from this area, and many have older siblings in the Scottsdale schools. Two exceptions are Cook's Tour in early November and Easter Monday.

### INSURANCE

Valley Presbyterian Day School is insured as required by the Arizona Department of Health Services (DHS) with liability insurance.
