Target age	A/B	Family Workshops	Description/Topics
Any	Milestone	Baptism Orientation	Baptismal Vows and what they mean. What baptism means.
3's/4's	Alternate years	Spiritual Leadership & Faith Talks	This class is designed to give families an overview of Sunday School, and Family Ministry. In addition, to encouraging families to understand the value and meaning of being a spiritual leader in their home and provide tips and support growing into that role.
3's/4's	Alternate years	Nightly Blessing	This class is designed to teach the benefits of and to equip families for blessing their children nightly.
K/1st	Alternate years	Praying together	This class is designed to teach techniques and equip families to pray frequently with their children.
K/1st	Alternate years	Worshipping Together	This class is designed to help parents guide their children in worship and give them techniques for encouraging a positive attitude toward worship as a family. (Also, supports worship progression toward worshipping as a student)
2 nd /3 rd	Alternate years	Cheerful Giver	This class is designed to help families talk about stewardship and put in place some of the elements of Dave Ramsey's <i>Financial Peace</i> class.
2 nd /3 rd	Alternate years	Serving together	This class is designed to help kids and adults understand the variety of ways in which we can serve our Lord, no matter what our age.
3 rd	Milestone	Reading the Bible	This class gives tips to families to support and encourage them spending time studying their bibles with their children.
5 th	Milestone	Worship & Communion	Fifth graders participate in a series on the meaning of communion while parents learn about giving their child a blessing.
6 th -12 th	Alternate years	Social Media & Faith	This 2 part class is designed to help parents understand social media better, to prevent negative impact and to look at it through a faith-based lens.
6 th -12 th	Alternate years	Facing Challenges	This class is designed for parents and 6 th -12 th graders to promote awareness, understanding and prevention of suicide and mental health issues from a Christian perspective.
12 th	Milestone	Tools for Takeoff- HS Graduation	Talking to your Senior about their faith and their future. Parent Class in fall followed by family activities that culminate in commissioning of Seniors.
